Musings from Pastor Dan

(The following is an except from a weekly letter I wrote Oct. 26th that included some very important information about disaffiliation.)

On Tuesday, October 18, The Peninsula-Delaware Conference Board of Trustees sent a letter regarding disaffiliation. Recall that St. Luke's, along with roughly one hundred other churches in our conference, sent a letter to the District Superintendent indicating the potential for St. Luke's to disaffiliate from the United Methodist Church. The letter was sent after the Conference Board of Trustees decided to add an additional charge of 50% of the church's property value for any church that decided to disaffiliate. We subsequently joined a law-suit to have the fee removed. The letter from the Conference Board states thus in part:

"We regret that we did not give more notice of the updated policy prior to its implementation on July 1, 2022. In order to alleviate any further harm to churches that were unprepared for the increased fiscal responsibility, the board will relax its grandfathering requirements and make the following compromise:

"Any church who sent notice to its Superintendent prior to July 1, 2022, will be allowed to follow the 2020 requirements as well as participate in the activity-based discernment. They will not be assessed a value of their real property."

Now that the property value cost has been removed, our Church Council needs to determine if St. Luke's is going to move ahead with disaffiliation or not. To that end, the Church Council wants to hold special informational meetings upon this topic. Two dates have been set, one daytime, and one evening meeting, so that we can provided a good time for as many church members to come and participate.

Our daytime meeting will be <u>Tuesday</u>, November 8 @10:00.

Our evening meeting will be held on <u>Thursday</u>, <u>November 10 @ 7:00</u>.

Both meetings will be held in Fellowship Hall. I pray you will be able to make one of these meetings.

New Bible Study Series Starts on Sunday, Nov. 6th


You go to church, read Scripture, and attend Bible study, so you're well-versed in God's ways. But do you actually *know* him?



Summary of Leadership Meeting October 20, 2022

Property and Investment Management

- Our investment agent at Merrill Lynch recommends keeping all investments the same at this time. We have made \$21K in income so far in 2022.
- ML recommended investing the proceeds from sale of parsonage into a 12-month FDIC insured CD at 4% (which could yield \$14K income in a year and be used toward the Pastor's Housing allowance.)
- Parsonage will settle Nov 21.
- Repairs to one of the Sanctuary HVAC units is being worked out.
- The FH floor and the sanctuary carpet have both been professionally cleaned. All tile floors to be stripped and waxed soon.

Mission and Ministry Team

- UMW Christmas brunch Nov 19th 10-12 at Laura Patrick's.
- Dec 18th is a 10am service (Living Creche program).
- Sherry Baker, team leader for the new Pastoral Care Team, reported that the ministry will start with a volunteer fellowship & training brunch Nov 5th.
- Trunk or Treat Oct 31st need volunteers (to bring candy in trunks.)
- Hospice Festival of Trees theme = coming home red & white (Dec 3rd and 4th).

Youth Group Update

- Three YG meetings so far with 7-9 youth attending regularly.
- Teen Bibles have been given out.
- Next event Nov 6th Bonfire at the Biddle's.
- Movie night fundraiser right before or after Christmas.
- Will be helping with OCC packing party on Nov 19th.

Finance Team (Report from Tracy Berrigan)

- 2023 Budget: Apportionment numbers not in the budget yet. 3.2% increase overall to budget from 2022.
- 2022 finances in very good shape Mostly under budget for expenditures and at expected levels for income.

• Date changed to Nov. 3rd at 6:30pm (by District Superintendent.)

Congregation Meetings to be scheduled in November to Discuss UMW Issues & Updates

- Per Pastor Dan, the requirements for disaffiliation need to be considered now that the Conference Trustees have removed the requirement of giving them 50% of the cost of property value to disaffiliate. These requirements are laborious and we need to understand them as we discern whether or not to disaffiliate.
- We may need a committee to move the congregation through an informed discernment process in deciding about disaffiliation IF the church makes this decision to consider disaffiliation from the UMW.
- In this context, the Congregational Meetings are an opportunity to give members needed information, allow them to ask questions, and to take a straw vote to see if members are interested in entering into the discernment process.
- We will schedule two meetings in November and then have the Church Council decide whether to enter the discernment process.
- Need to make sure people understand that in order to vote on the question about disaffiliation, they need to be members of the church; we will put out info in all communications so that people know this and understand the variety of pathways to membership and find out who is interested in becoming a member.




